Liberian-born "critical essential infrastructure workers" without US citizenship or LPR status, who arrived in 2014 or earlier	7,900
The median personal income of Liberians without US citizenship or LPR status, who arrived in 2014 or earlier	\$23,000
The median household income of households with at least one member that is a Liberian without US citizenship or LPR status, who arrived in 2014 or earlier	\$46,000
